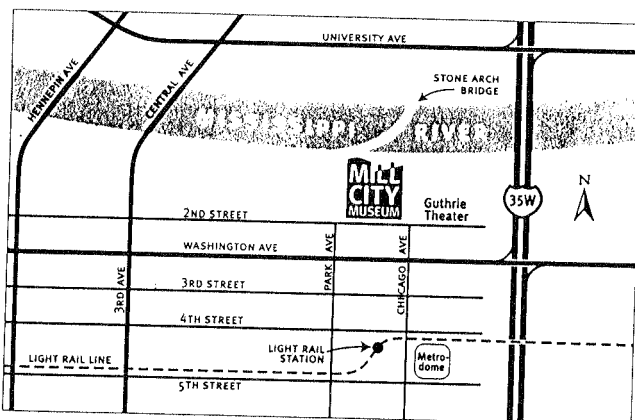
Cost: \$10 per adult

- Cafe with snacks & sandwiches

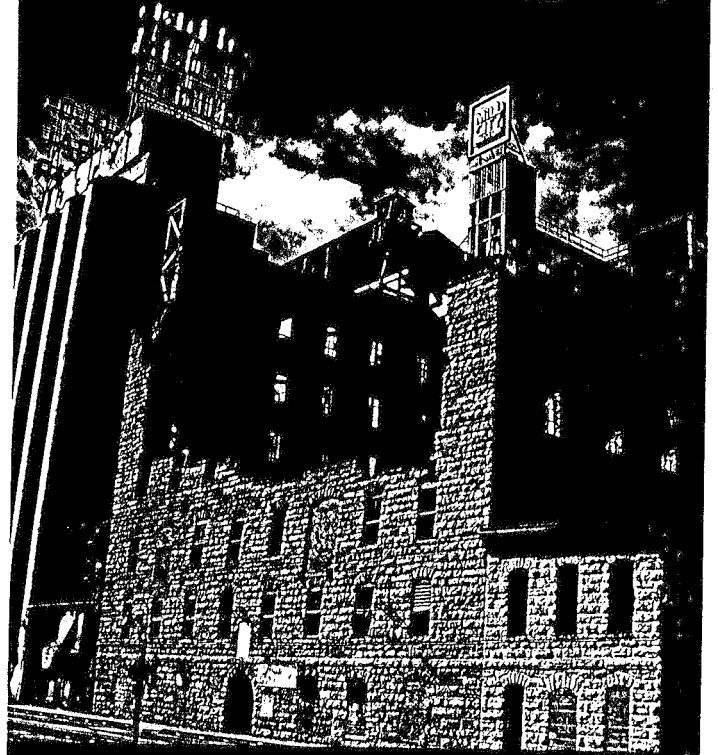
