#### Men cannot say they do not know about God. From the beginning of the world, men could see what God is like through the things He has made. This shows His power that lasts forever. It shows that He is God. Rom. 1:20

People have different perspectives about many things. Some people will say the Iowa Hawkeyes are the best. Other people will say Iowa is no good, the Iowa State Cyclones are much better. The people see the same teams but think about them very differently.

The same is true about how we see life and the world. This is called our worldview. Christians have a Christian worldview. We see the world the way God teaches us. Unbelievers don't see the world the same way. They think about life and the world from their sinful perspective, not from God's perspective.

Does that matter? Yes, how you see the world is very important! There are many ways Christians think different from the world. We will look at six very important ways we think and believe the way God wants, and not the same as the world. In each newsletter this year, we will look at one topic and what that means for us.

What is one way Christians think differently from unbelievers? We believe God made the world.

Think about that. That is a very simple statement, but it means there are many differences between us and unbelievers! Just look at these examples.

If God didn't make me	Because God made me
There is no God.	There is an eternal God.
This world is all there is. No heaven, no hell. I have my life on earth and that is all.	God is much greater than the world. My time on earth is not all there is. God has bigger plans beyond this.
I don't know where I came from or why I'm here. My life has no purpose or meaning.	I know where I came from and why I'm here. God gives my life purpose & meaning.
People's lives aren't valuable. Abortion is okay, killing sick or old people is okay.	God makes every life valuable. No matter people are babies, old, sick, everyone is valuable to God and to us.

If God didn't make me	Because God made me
There is no God, so there is no relationship with Him.	God made us to have a close relationship with Him.
The world belongs to us. We can do anything we want with it.	The world belongs to God because He made it. We take care of it the way <u>He</u> wants.
I have to take care of myself.	I trust God to take care of me.

You can probably think of more differences, but we will save some of these ideas for future articles. But that is enough that you can see how important it is for us to know and believe that God made everything.

Many Christians don't know how important this is. They believe in God, but they don't think He made the world. They think the world evolved (life slowly happened over billions of years). But if they think God didn't create everything, you can see how that leads to more wrong belief.

That is why our church continues to teach and preach that God is our Creator, as we say in the Apostles' Creed every week: I believe in God the Father Almighty, He made heaven and earth. Remember this important teaching, that God made everything, including you!

Many Christians can remember that God made everything in 6 days and rested on the 7<sup>th</sup> day. But what did He make every day? That can be more difficult to remember. Get out your Bible and read Genesis 1:1-2:3. Reading and studying God's word is always the most important way to learn what He says and does.

You can also read Gen. 1:1-2:3 with this drawing. This is an easy way to see what God made on each of the 6 days. I got this drawing from Pastor Ron Friedrich, but this idea has been around long before him. Make your own drawing to help you remember how to do this.

Start by getting a sheet of paper. Draw two lines across it to divide it into three parts.

Day 1. Write a "1" in the upper left corner. Draw a circle and shade half of it black. On Day 1, God made light. He separated the light and darkness.

Day 2. Write a "2" in the left corner of the middle section. Draw clouds above and water below. On Day 2, God put water in two places – the sky above and on the earth.


Day 3. Write a "3" in the left corner of the bottom section. Draw dry ground and plants. On Day 3, God separated the water and dry ground on earth. Then He made all kinds of plants.

Day 4. Go back up to the top section and write a "4" in the top right corner. Draw the sun, moon and stars in the sky. On Day 1, God made light, but He didn't yet put anything in the sky. On Day 4, God put the sun, moon, stars and planets in the sky.

Day 5. Write a "5" in the middle section on the right side. Draw birds in the sky and fish in the sea. On Day 2, God made the sky and He separated the water (clouds) in the sky and water on the earth. But nothing lived there yet. Now on Day 5, God put living things in the sky and the water. He made birds in the sky and all water animals in the water.

Day 6. Write a "6" in the bottom section on the right side. Draw land animals and a man and a woman. On Day 3, God made dry land and plants. On Day 6, God put animals on land. God also made people (Adam and Eve) on Day 6.

Then all God's work of creating was finished. He looked at everything He had made and said it was all very good. Then on the  $7^{\text{th}}$  day He rested.
