We are continuing in our study of people in the Bible, how God used regular people to serve Him and do great things. Gideon was a leader in the Old Testament before Israel had kings. These leaders were called Judges and you can read about them in the book of Judges. God chose them to save Israel from their enemies and to lead the people back to God. You can read about Gideon in Judges 6:1-8:35. *Answers are on page 4*.

1. All through the book of Judges, the people of Israel left God and worshiped idols. Then God punished them and let an enemy nation rule Israel. What nation ruled Israel now? Judges 6:1,6.

2. The people of Israel asked who to help (save) them? Judges 6:6

3. The Angel of the Lord came to Gideon. What was Gideon's complaint? Judges 6:11-13

4. The Lord said He is sending who to save Israel? Judges 6:14

5. Gideon doubted he could save Israel. Why? What did he think was wrong with him and his family? Judges 6:15

6. When God calls us to follow and serve Him, He doesn't let us follow other gods or idols. Gideon's father had an altar to worship the idol Baal. What did God say to do? Judges 6:25-27

7. God made Gideon brave to call together an army. But Gideon still doubted, and he wanted proof God will help him. What proof did Gideon ask for, and God gave? Judges 6:36-38

8. One proof wasn't enough. Gideon wanted more proof. Did God give it? Is it okay for us to ask God for proof like this? Judges 6:39-40, 1 Corinthians 10:9

9. Gideon had 32,000 men for his army. What did God think about that? Why? Judges 7:1-2

10. God reduced the size of the army to 300 men (Judges 7:7-8). What were their weapons? Judges 7:16-20

11. How could 300 men beat over 120,000 men in the Midianite army? Judges 7:21-25

12. Our biggest enemies are sin, death and the devil. What did Jesus do to them? 1 Peter 3:18, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22, Colossians 2:13-15

13. Remember Gideon's complaint in Judges 6:13, and God's answer in 6:14? How does God give us victories in our life? 1 John 5:4, John 16:33, Romans 8:37-39, Philippians 4:13.

#### Answers to Dive Into God's Word, p. 2.

- 1. The nation of Midian ruled Israel now. The Midianites were very mean to Israel and attacked them often and stole from them.
- 2. The people of Israel cried out to the Lord to save them.
- 3. Gideon said that the Lord saved His people in the past. If God is with them now, why isn't God saving them? Gideon didn't understand why God wasn't saving them.
- 4. The Lord said He was sending Gideon to save Israel. Notice if you want God to help people, He might send you to help them!
- 5. In Israel, the larger families had more power and respect. Gideon was from a small tribe (Manasseh). He was also from the smallest clan (family group) in Manasseh, and he was the least important man in his father's family. This is like not choosing an experienced army general to lead a battle, but instead choosing an army cook with no fighting experience. God chose Gideon, but Gideon couldn't understand why God would choose him.
- 6. God told Gideon to destroy the altar to Baal, and cut down the Asherah pole (another idol). God also told him to build an altar for the Lord. In other words, stop worshiping idols and worship only the true God.
- 7. Gideon put fleece (wool from a sheep) on the ground. He asked God to make the fleece wet with dew overnight and keep the ground dry. God made no dew go on the ground, but much dew in the fleece. There was enough water in the fleece, Gideon could wring it out and fill a bowl with water.
- 8. Yes, God gave more proof. The first time, Gideon wanted the ground dry and the fleece wet with dew. Now he wanted the opposite. He asked God to make the ground wet with dew and keep the fleece dry. God did that. The Bible warns us not to test God. Deuteronomy 6:16 says, "You will not put the Lord your God to the test." Psalm 78:41, Psalm 95:9, and 1 Corinthians 10:9 show that it is not right to test God. When the devil tempted Jesus to jump off the temple and prove God will save Him, Jesus answered, "You will not put the Lord your God to the test."
- 9. God said that was too many men. If Israel had a large army and won the battle, they will think they won because of their strength. God wanted them to have a small army so they will know God won the battle for them.
- 10. Each man had a torch, an empty jar, and a trumpet. Those were their main weapons to start the battle.
- 11. God made the Midianite army confused and fight and kill each other. After the army ran away, then the Israelite army chased them and fought them.
- 12. Jesus defeated all our enemies. He suffered to forgive our sins. He rose alive again and promises that we will rise alive. And He took away the devil's power to hurt us.
- 13. When we belong to Christ, the world will attack us, but no one can take us away from Him. Jesus defeated the world and He gives us that victory. Nothing can separate us from Him and His love for us. And He gives us strength to get through any trouble, no matter how bad. That is His promise for you, even if you think you are not an important person. God loves and cherishes you!
